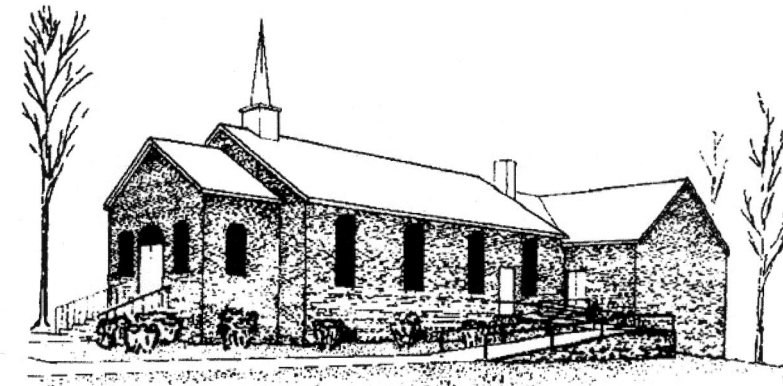
BIBLE STUDY: *Half Truths* by Adam Hamilton: There will be a snack supper at 6:00 and child care is available during the class.
