OUR NEIGHBORS—The Northern Stokes Food Pantry is feeding over 70 area families every two weeks. Summer is a hard time for the pantry and Second Harvest Food Bank. With kids out of school, they do not receive breakfast or lunch each day (putting more strain on the family’s resources). Donations to Second Harvest and the Food Pantry usually drop off during the summer months. In addition, the recent tornadoes in Guilford and Rockingham counties have also put a strain on these resources. You may always bring food items to the church, drop off a check payable to Second Harvest Food Bank or Northern Stokes Food Pantry in the offering plate and they will be passed on to the organizations (they can buy food much more economically than we can as individuals.)

STOKES MISSIONAL NETWORK PROJECT—On September 16 at 9:00 a.m. the churches of the Stokes Missional Network will be working together to build a very long ramp (up to 44 feet) on a home in Pinnacle. Each church in the network is asked to participate in the project through: prayer, donations of time or money, and/or providing a noon meal for the workers. 
