THANK YOU: To everyone who helped yesterday with our Summer Sweat to Serve. There are always things to do around the church. If you have time available, your help is appreciated.

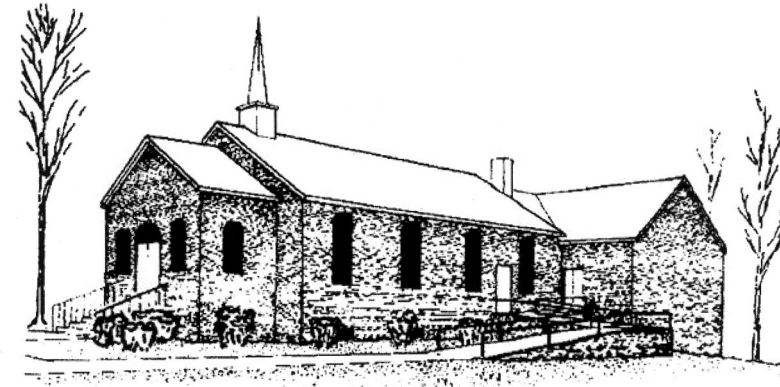
