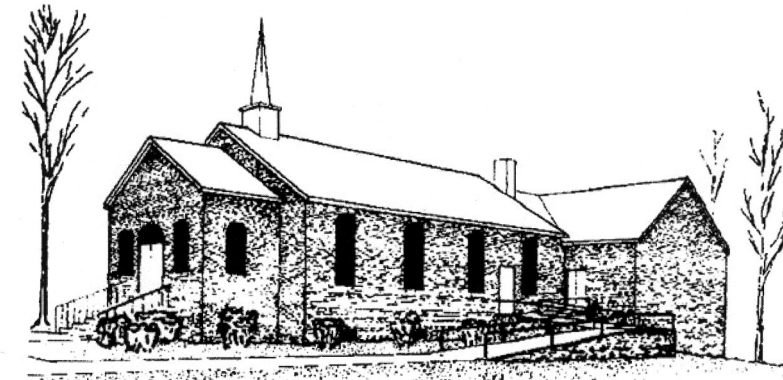
**October Edition of *The Snow Hill Connection*** (*church newsletter*) is available in the Narthex.
